# HOW TO GO TO CAMP:

1. Be Born

For instance: Let's say you leave a deposit of \$75 on April 2. Then, on June 1, you want to pay the rest of your bill. You would only owe \$75 more because your deposit locked you into Phase One.

Deposits are non-refundable. Once you've paid your deposit that money is used to pay for food, T-shirts, accommodations and is no longer available. So be sure that you're really going.
